

THE MINOR PENTATONIC SCALE




- + There are 5 patterns that make up the minor pentatonic scale on the guitar.
- + The minor Pentatonic Scale is made up of 5 notes taken from the minor scale.
- + The Notes are numbers 1 b3 4 5 b7
- + So in the key of A Minor for example the notes will be A C D E G


Here are the 5 patterns you need to learn written in A Minor. The purple notes are the root notes, so if you start pattern 1 on an A then all the purple notes will be an A.

If you want to be in G Minor you need to have your roots on G! So pattern 1 would be on fret 3!




